Dear Parent / Guardian,

Thank you for expressing an interest in using our S823 bus service from Stoney Stanton and Sapcote to Brockington College.

Bus routes:

The bus will serve Stoney Stanton, Sapcote, Croft and Huncote. This bus will drop off and pick up in the school grounds. Bus routes and timetables will be available to view on our website: www.andrews-coaches.co.uk from July 2018.

Behaviour:

All students are expected to behave appropriately whilst onboard our buses and any anti-social behaviour may result in the student being removed from the bus service. Parents and students are encouraged to report incidents of anti-social behaviour or any concerns they may have to us as soon as possible so that we can deal with any issues. CCTV images and audio is now recorded on our school buses for increased student safety.

Registering a seat:

Arrangements have been made to accommodate all the students that have previously travelled on this bus and the new academic year intake. Please return this application as soon as possible so it can be processed.

No pass no travel:

Please be aware that we do operate a **NO PASS NO TRAVEL** policy on all of our school buses both in the morning and in the afternoon. This is due to a number of reasons:

- Our contracts are a paid service for students and carrying a valid bus pass proves that you are up to date with your payments.
- Our school bus services are a 'closed' service and are not open to the general public, carrying a valid bus pass proves you are entitled to travel on that vehicle.
- For insurance reasons we can only carry students that are officially registered with us on a specific contract. If an accident occurs, we are able to contact the parents of those students that travel on that vehicle. However if a student travels without a valid bus pass they may not be registered with us and hence we will not be able to account for them.
- Students may have had a bus pass removed for anti social behaviour or bullying.

Our drivers will not know the reason a student does not have a valid bus pass and so to protect the interests of all students anyone without a valid bus pass will be refused travel.

Bus passes:

Replacement bus passes can be obtained at a cost of **£10.00**.

Please contact us or alternatively inform the school office that you require a replacement. Temporary bus passes can be obtained from the school office during the school day and includes a section for a return morning journey to the school.

If a student finds they have lost a bus pass before a morning journey please call our office and we may have time to notify our driver to allow the student to travel that morning.

If a student is found to be abusing their bus pass by lending it to another student, using another student's or attempting to use a fraudulent bus pass then they will be removed from our school bus service immediately.

Payments:

The price is **£3.25** per student per day.

The total price for the 2018/2019 academic year is **£617.50**.

A non refundable deposit of **£40.00** is required to secure your seat and must be sent with your initial application.

We offer a choice of payment options for the remaining balance:

Option 1:

Pay the total cost for the year up front for a £15.00 discount:

The payment of **£562.50** for the year is due on **1st September 2018**.

(£3.25 x 190 school days - £40.00 deposit - £15.00 discount = £562.50)

Option 2:

Set up a monthly standing order direct to our account for a £7.50 discount:

(£3.25 x 190 school days - £40.00 deposit - £7.50 discount = £570.00)

You will need to set up 10 monthly payments from September 2018 to June 2019 inclusive.

The first payment of **£57.00** will be due on **1st September 2018**.

Then nine further monthly payments of **£57.00** on the 1st of each of the following months.

If you select this option we will send you our account details and a reference to put on your standing order so we can identify your payments.

Option 3:

Pay by cheque in half term instalments as they are due:

When paying by cheque please make cheques payable to 'Andrews of Leicester Ltd' and post it to us at the address on the front page of this information pack. Please ensure that you write the student's name and reference number on the back of the cheque.

Days off:

Unfortunately we cannot refund bus fares for days off the students may have or for any unforeseen closures i.e snow days.

Cancelling your subscription:

If you find that you no longer need to use our bus service you must give us at least 5 working days notice that the student will be leaving the bus and return their bus pass to us.

Application form:

1. Fill in the form at the bottom of the page.

Please select your payment option.

Providing us with an email address is optional but allows us to send you confirmation that we have received your application and send you information relevant to your subscription.

2. Provide us with a passport sized photograph of the student for a bus pass.

By signing the form below you agree that a copy of this photo will be securely stored by us to identify the students travelling with us and also for use if the student requires a replacement bus pass.

3. Sign the form below.

By signing this form you give permission for us to carry the student named on the form to and from Brockington College on our vehicles and also agree to the subscription payments for our service that we have detailed in this information pack.
